Dear Robert,

I must confess that it is very likely at the moment the project remote voting will not be performed in the planned way, with the parliamentary elections coming up in November already (an exact date has not been fixed yet). The Electoral Council will not be included anymore in the procedure. There'll be a much shorter process which aims at Internetvoting in a more simple way, using a system which has been used in the elections for waterboards. Only the necessary changes in the system will be made, because of the time-limit the project is suddenly facing. Dear Robert,

I promised you to contact you about the meeting of the 10th of July. I am a little bit delayed, but as you probably read in the newspapers we're having a cabinetcrisis at the moment in the Netherlands with the possibility of early elections, maybe in the fall. I hope you understand we had very busy days.

We wondered wether it would be best to cancel our appointment, but reached the conclusion that, in the case the elections will be in May 2007 (the normal date, still possible) we need to put in motion the procedure of the testing.
